### **Team Rules:**

1. Five (5) people maximum. Four people for the race plus one optional alternate. A single substitution is allowed.
2. Helmets, kneepads, elbow pads, athletic shoes encouraged for everyone on the team. Fun attire that promote your city, station, career is also encouraged!
3. The use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs prohibited.
4. Every team member MUST sign a race waiver.

### **Racing Information:**

1. Race distance is around the City of Elyria parking lot on Second Street. Course distance is 200 yards and includes (2) turns!
2. Team members will be stationed at various tag –off points on the course.
3. All races will be run in Heats of 2. Heats will be chosen prior to race day registration.
4. On race day teams will draw for lane assignment for first heat. Lane assignments for category finals will be determined prior to race.
5. Race Teams will start in staggered lanes.
6. Each Race Team will stay in their lane throughout the race. A Team interfering with another Team will be disqualified and the interfered Team has the option of a restart.
7. The winner of each heat will advance to the next round until final two teams remain to race for the overall winner.

# 2016 First Responders Obstacle Fun Run Waiver & Release Form

## 1. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE

Family Promise of Lorain County, Friendship Animal Protective League, The City of Elyria, the promoters and sponsors, other participants, operators, assigns, heirs and the next of kin for any and all damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or competing, officiating in, observing or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event.

2. **HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS** the releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.

3. **HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OF PROPERTY DAMAGE** due to the negligence of releases or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.

**THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements of inducements apart from the forgoing written agreement have been made.

This waiver, release and indemnification agreement specifically embraces each and every event sanction, authorized or promoted by said releases during the entire season and applies to each and every event, or activity hereinabove mentioned, and has same effect as if executed after each and every activity or event in which the undersigned participates so that the parties herein intended to be released and indemnified shall be fully and effectively released and indemnified as to each and every event hereinabove described.
